Containing 7.0 g/litre of glyphosate, Easy-Weed is diluted ready-to-use, and the spray is discharged as a light foam. This persists on the sprayed foliage for several minutes, allowing the user to easily see the weeds that have been treated.

No more hand weeding!

No one likes hand-weeding in the garden. It's hard back-breaking work and it's impossible to remove all the weed roots.

Easy-Weed is the season-long answer to weeds in the garden. It can be used from March through to October on most garden weeds. Used as often as necessary, Easy-weed can keep the garden clear of weeds all year round.



Easy-Weed kills most types of annual and perennial non-woody weeds such as bindweed, docks, nettles and grasses in the garden. Use on patios, paths, gravelled areas, along lawn edges, fence lines and on ground that is to be planted with vegetables, flowers, or other plants.

Easy-Weed is taken into the leaves and other green parts of the plant, and then travels through the plant, killing the shoots and roots.



HOW TO USE

Shake well before use. Turn spray nozzle to open and spray to just wet the weeds, so that run-off is avoided. The foam spray will remain on the leaves for a few minutes, indicating weeds that have been sprayed. Turn nozzle to off after use.

Easy-Weed should be used when the weeds are growing actively and when they have sufficient leaf area to absorb the spray. The ideal time for application to annual weeds is Spring to Autumn and for perennial weeds is from June to August. Do not spray in windy conditions and avoid drift onto wanted plants.

Easy-Weed will normally work with a single application, but some deep rooted weeds (such as ground elder) may require repeat applications if they re-grow.

Easy-Weed takes about 8 hours to be fully taken in by the plant. If rain occurs within this time, it may be less effective, and have to be re-applied. Weeds will normally die within a few days but may take up to 4 weeks, depending on the growing and climate conditions. Wait for 7 days before cultivating the soil to allow Easy-Weed to move into the roots.

Easy-Weed is broken down by soil bacteria. Foliage from dead or dying weeds can be used for making compost or dug into the soil without any risk to newly sown seeds or transplants.

WARNINGS

Spray or Spray drift must not come into contact with lawns or cultivated plants. If cultivated plants are treated accidentally, IMMEDIATELY wash the weedkiller off the leaves with as much water as possible. Do not walk on the sprayed area until the spray has dried on the leaves, to avoid any transfer onto lawns or other plants.
